### **Ga FIB Update**

Hooray! The power supply for the Omniprobe controller has been replaced, and the probe tip appears to be functioning as normal. As of 5/28, the Omniprobe tip has been changed and sharpened. However, there have been some sporadic error messages in the xT Control software, the most recent of which concerned heating for Pt deposition. The "heat" button had to be clicked twice, and then the Pt deposition worked as usual.

In addition, there is a large difference between the i-beam and e-beam images at 0 degrees. There should be enough i-beam shift to complete your work, and the alignment will be looked into further. If you are using the Ga FIB (or any RSC tool) and experience an error message, please let staff know ASAP.

## The Gator Safe App Has Weather And Hurricane Alerts.

Remember if UF closes due to weather, that includes RSC facilities

Be sure you have an evacuation/loss of power readiness kit ready BEFORE the storms form. You should create your kit in a bag that you can easily take with you. Some recommended items to include are:

- Non-perishable food (enough to last at least 3 days) and manual can opener.
- Water (enough to last at least 3 days) 1 gallon/person/day.
- First-aid kit (include any prescription medications you may need)
- Personal hygiene items and sanitation items (hand sanitizer gel)
- Flashlights (have extra batteries on hand)
- Battery operated radio (again, have extra batteries)
- Waterproof container with cash and important documents
- Lighter or matches
